A. - T/B 1115 site A62. Dive bombing mission. Group of three squadrons: A410, 12 planes; A411, 12 planes; A412, 12 planes. 36 F-47 aircraft. "A" Squadron attacked as follows: Pooty vectored to area southwest part of city of Aachen A-6343 and laid 3 red smoke bombs on target. 31 bombs in area which was left in flames and smoke; no detailed observation possible due to smoke. Pooty reported "excellent results". Upon completion of above mission, Pooty vectored to tanks in vicinity of Heiden A-8949; lead squadrons couldn't locate and gas ran low; did not carry out. "C" Squadron was vectored to target by Pooty on "J" and was told to drop on town. 31 bombs in area on north side of town A-64043. All bombs hit in target area. 3 bombs on railroad station at A-644233. Station destroyed. "C" Squadron dropped 27 bombs in southwest portion of Aachen when directed there by Pooty who marked area with red smoke. All bombs hit in area but no results were observed. Group was over the target area from 1200 hours to 1230 hours. Flak encountered: Heavy and light, meagre, accurate about 4 miles north of Aachen, A-6948. Heavy, moderate, and accurate at A-620447. Heavy, weak inaccurate over A-680449, A-640433, A-670449, and A-603473. T/B 1345 site A62.
