- T/U 1436 Site A89. Area cover for medium bombers. Group of three squadrons: A410, 12 planes; B411, 12 planes; C412, 12 planes. 36 P-47 aircraft. R/V made with bombers on time. "A" Squadron R/V with bombers, 36 B-26's at 14,000 feet with bombers at 12,000 feet at 1506 hours over target, railroad bridge in the vicinity of Konz-Karthaus (L-1623). Escorted bombers about 20 miles west of target and left them to pick up 36 bombers flying east unescorted. Escorted these mixed B-26's and A-20's to target, railroad bridge at L-243315 in the vicinity of Pfalzal. Controller called 50 bandits in Bonn Area but none seen. Heavy, intense flak fired at bombers over L-1623; accuracy not observed. Weather: 10/10, base unknown, top 5,000 feet with scattered clouds visible below, visibility unlimited through breaks over target. Group was over the target area from 1506 hours to 1605 hours. T/D 1700 hours Site A89.
